

Organization of the Supplementary Knowledge Course for Candidates Applying to the Master's Program in Law, 2025

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Pursuant to Decision No. 1783/QĐ-ĐHL and Decision No. 1784/QĐ-ĐHL dated 30 November 2023 issued by the Rector of VNU School of Law on the promulgation of master's training programs, VNU School of Law, Vietnam National University, Hanoi, announces the organization of a supplementary knowledge course for candidates applying to the Master's program in Law in 2025. Candidates who complete the course will be issued a certificate confirming eligibility to sit the Master's entrance examination in Law. The certificate is valid for 02 years from the date of issuance to the date of registration for the entrance examination.

- Criminal Law and Criminal Procedure (applied orientation)
- Economic Law (applied orientation)
